Job description:

The NCCR North-South recently launched 15 interdisciplinary research projects with a duration of up to 4 years. Each research project will work in at least 2 partnership regions of the NCCR North-South, using a comparative approach. Research projects are mixed groups of researchers from different disciplines, led by a team of post-doctoral researchers from the North and the South.

For a research project active in Bolivia, Cuba, Mexico and Peru (i.e. Central America and South America) we are seeking to employ a postdoctoral researcher and co-leader. The project is entitled 'The transformation of multifunctional agrarian systems in Latin America'. The expansion of export-oriented industrial agriculture is a great challenge to the existing multifunctional agrarian systems in Latin America. Public policies in the different Latin American countries reflect varying degrees of state intervention in large-scale as well as small-scale agrarian systems. The main objective of this project is to better understand – and act upon – the governance of natural resources and bio-cultural diversity in the context of the transformation of multifunctional agrarian systems.
